Bible Group at St Mary Magdalen: The Bible Study Group will continue this week as normal on Thursday with a morning session at 10:30 am followed by a second session at 7:15 in the evening – both sessions being in the Garden Room. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion: We are looking to commission further Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion as the number that we have has dwindled recently. The lay person commissioned in this role assists the priest in distributing the Eucharist at Mass and administering the Precious Blood from the chalice when Communion is offered under both kinds. The Minister may also be asked to assist in taking Holy Communion to parishioners who are sick or housebound. If you feel you could be of service to the parish in this role, please speak initially to Fr Luke, or one of our existing ministers.
