Please pray for him and for those who are treating him.

Meanwhile, I am extremely grateful to Fr Matthias Odigbo. He will be serving in our Diocese for the next eighteen months before he returns home. He has generously agreed to look after S Mary Magdalene's parish until such time as Fr Matthew is able to return home. Fr Matthias has also agreed to minister as the Chaplain to the Ipswich Hospital during this time. I would ask you to collaborate with him in his ministry, to support him and to encourage him.
