I would like to thank you all for your kind words and for all your support after announcing last week that I will sadly moving in September.

When Bishop Alan asked me to move here in November I was so looking forward to settling into the parish, where for the first time I found a home. Unfortunately with my Dad's health taking a turn for the worst in December, it made me realise how far away I am for them and I do miss them greatly!

Family is really important to me.

When I preached about the difference between a house and home a few weeks ago, I was already aware that I could be on the move and that homily I found hard to preach. A home is not only where we feel safe, love and cared for, but it can also be about our roots and memories.

I left the North East in 2002 to go to University in London and it was not until I began Seminary in 2015 that I really began to spend long periods of time up there again. I rediscovered the beauty of my home county and Northumbria.

Since December, my desire to be less than 280 miles away from my parents has increasingly grown. This therefore led me to approach Bishop Alan to ask for his support in moving back home. A three year loan period has been agreed and I will be moving to the Diocese of Hexham and Newcastle in September, with my last weekend here probably being the 11/12 September; though this is still to be confirmed.

I would like to organise a Mass of Thanksgiving and Celebration for my time here and for the amazing people that I have met both here and across the Diocese of East Anglia. I would like this to take place on the weekend of the August Bank holiday, **SUNDAY 29TH AUGUST** with **ONE SUNDAY MASS** at **11am**, followed by a garden party where people bring along their own picnics and join together as one community to share the joys that we all have in our lives.
