New Bishop is appointed for the Diocese of East Anglia

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, has appointed Rev Canon Peter Collins, a priest of the Archdiocese of Cardiff, as the fifth Bishop of East Anglia.

Bishop Alan Hopes has been appointed as the Apostolic Administrator until the Ordination and Installation of Bishop-elect Peter Collins takes place.

The Episcopal Ordination of Bishop-Elect Peter Collins will take place at the Cathedral Church of St John the Baptist, Norwich, on December 14, 2022 at 11.30am.
