

**Today's Gospel:** In today's Gospel, Jesus greets his disciples with the gift of peace. Jesus then commissions his disciples to continue the work that he has begun; as Jesus was sent by God, so Jesus sends his disciples. He gives his disciples the gift of the Holy Spirit so that they will be able to accomplish this task. Jesus' words to his disciples also highlight the integral connection between the forgiveness of sins and the gift of the Holy Spirit. With the grace of the Holy Spirit, we can share forgiveness and reconciliation with others. Thomas, the doubting disciple in today's reading, represents the reality of the Church that comes after this first community of witnesses to Jesus. All but the first disciples of Jesus must believe without seeing. Like Thomas, we may doubt the news that Jesus, who was crucified and buried, appeared to his disciples. Our human nature seeks hard evidence that the Jesus who appeared to his disciples after his death is indeed the same Jesus who was crucified. Thomas is given the opportunity to be our representative in

obtaining this evidence. He gives witness to us that the Jesus who was raised is the same Jesus who died and through the gift of the Holy Spirit, we are among those who are blessed, for we have not seen and yet believe. *Courtesy Loyola Press*.

**Weekday Masses:** Please note that there will be no weekday Masses during the coming week as Fr Paul is away on pilgrimage to Medjugorje, returning for the weekend Mass next Saturday.

**International Evening:** The next social event in the parish will be on Saturday April 27<sup>th</sup>, when there will be an International Evening held in the parish hall, starting at 7:00 pm. This event will allow you to partake of food provided from the many nationalities in our parish congregation. Tickets, costing £12 for adults and £5 for children (under 10s free), will be on sale after Masses this weekend, or alternatively you can call 07722 971188. Tickets must be purchased in advance to allow numbers to be reckoned for catering purposes. The parish hall is not licensed for the sale of alcohol, so you will need to bring with you any drinks you want to consume on the night, together with your own glasses. The evening will also feature music and dancing and should be a great night to socialise with your fellow parishioners, and celebrate the multicultural nature of our parish community.

**Gift Aid:** Would all those parishioners who normally make their weekly offering using Gift Aid envelopes please note that their new 2024/25 envelopes are now available for collection from the Narthex. If you can't find your envelopes in the box please write your name on the sheet provided for this purpose and they will be made available to you next week. If anyone who has already signed up to giving by Gift Aid has changed their address during the last year, or did not pay sufficient income or capital gains tax to cover the tax reclaimable on their offerings, then please notify either Fr. Luke, Fr. Paul or Chris Croker (Gift Aid Co-ordinator).

**When Will I Be Chosen?:** Dates for your diaries – the first showings of *The Chos*en will be held in the parish hall starting at 6:30 pm on the first four Saturdays in June: the 1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd.</sup> We want as many people as possible to come along and watch this amazing production so put these dates in your diaries now.
