Today's Gospel: In this week's Gospel reading, Jesus talks about what it means to be prepared to receive the Kingdom of Heaven. It follows a series of warnings and predictions by Jesus about the coming of the Son of Man. Jesus wants his disciples to understand that the exact day and time cannot be predicted and teaches the disciples that they must remain vigilant so that they will not be caught unprepared....The Christian community for whom Matthew wrote this Gospel was coming to terms with the realisation that the promise of Jesus' return would not be fulfilled within their lifetimes. The question remains for us to ask ourselves, are we ready to receive Jesus? Will we be prepared to receive him? *Courtesy Loyola Press*

Remembrance Day: Today is Remembrance Sunday - a national opportunity to remember the service and sacrifice of all those that have defended our freedoms and protected our way of life. We remember the Armed Forces, and their families, from Britain and the Commonwealth, the vital role played by the emergency services and those of all nations and nationalities who have lost their lives as a result of conflict or terrorism. At the end of the 10:00 Mass, we will pause for a two-minute silence to reflect on the service and sacrifice the Armed Forces make on our behalf.

The Alpha Course: On Wednesday this week, the first session of the Alpha course will be held at 12:30 in the Garden Room at St Mary Magdalens and at 7:30 pm in the hall at St Marks for those that have registered. The St Mary Magdalen session will include a light lunch and the evening session at St Mark's will include a cooked meal.

Welcome: Today we welcome Alias Zizka into the Catholic Church and our parish community when he is baptised at 12 noon. Please remember Alias in your prayers and also pray for his parents and godparents that they may guide their child to a full and meaningful relationship with Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Find Christmas Appeal 2023: Like last year, FIND is again focusing its Christmas appeal on gift vouchers and store gift cards which can be passed to those in Ipswich less fortunate than us. Between now and Christmas, FIND will be issuing some 900 food boxes to make sure it can provide for Christmas and January. Having store vouchers will enable people to buy fresh foods or gifts of toys, clothes and other items. Suggested providers are Sainsbury's, ASDA, ALDI, Co-op, Waitrose, Smythes, The Entertainer toy store, Argos, Primark and M&S. Any vouchers donated must have receipts with them so that it is certain that they have been 'loaded'. If you are able to respond to this appeal, please put any donated vouchers or gift cards, along with the corresponding receipt, in an envelope marked FIND Christmas Appeal and drop it in the collection plate at any Mass no later than Sunday 17th December to allow for collection and distribution.

Parish 150 Club: The November prize draw of the parish 150 Club is due to be made on Sunday 26th November. However, owing to holiday absences, this draw will be postponed and will instead be made after the 10:00 am Mass on Sunday 17th December. Hall Working Party: Thank you to all those who gave up their time on Saturday morning to help with the ongoing work tidying up the church hall. The opportunity was also taken to complete the lighting upgrade in the hall. The old fluorescent lighting has all now been replaced with bright and effective energy-efficient LED lighting which will both reduce running costs and simplify ongoing maintenance.

Book of Remembrance: In the Catholic Church the month of November begins with the Solemnity of All Saints' on November 1st, followed by the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed – All Souls' Day' on the 2nd November. Together these days mark the start of a month of remembrance, often referred to as the month of the dead, during which we remember and pray especially for our loved ones who have gone before us and whose loss we feel. On the table at the back of the church there is a Book of Remembrance, and you are all invited to write in this the names of those family members and friends who have died, who will then be remembered especially during Masses throughout this month.

Free to a Good Home: If anybody has use for some 1500mm (5 ft) fluorescent light fittings complete with tube and diffuser, there are still some available free of charge.
