

Advent Wreath – Gaudete Sunday: Certain Sundays throughout the liturgical year have taken their names from the first word in Latin of the Introit, the entrance antiphon at Mass. Gaudete Sunday is one of these. The name comes from Philippians 4:4-5 Gaudete in Domino semper – Rejoice in the Lord always. Gaudete Sunday is a joyous celebration. Although it takes place during the penitential period of Advent, Gaudete Sunday serves as a mid-point break from the austere practices to rejoice in the nearness of Jesus' return. Like Lent, Advent is a penitential season, so the priest normally wears purple vestments, but on Gaudete Sunday, having passed the midpoint of Advent, the Church lightens

the mood a little, and the priest may wear rose vestments. Similarly, today, the pink or rose-coloured candle of our Advent Wreath is lit. This pink candle is customarily called the Shepherds Candle and it represents joy:

"And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Saviour has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord.""

Dependent Priests Fund: The Dependent Priests Fund is a charity run by priests of the diocese, but independent of the diocese, to support priests in mainly medical, but also in general need. There will be a retiring collection taken for this cause after each Mass this weekend – collectors please note. Please Gift Aid your donations if you can, but note that, as this is a charity independent of the diocese, it has a separate charity registration number and as such the special Gift Aid envelopes provided must be used and not the printed Diocesan ones.

Christmas Mass Times: On Sunday 24th December, morning Masses will be at 8:00 am and 10:am as normal, celebrating the Fourth Sunday of Advent. On Sunday evening at 10:00 pm the Mass of Christmas Night will be celebrated and on Monday December 25th, there will the Mass of Christmas Day at 10:00 am. Please note that there will be no 8:00 am Mass on Christmas morning. Catholics are obliged to attend Mass for both the 4th Sunday of Advent and for Christmas.

Christmas Flowers: The church will be prepared for Christmas on Friday 22nd December starting at 1:00 pm when the flowers will be arranged, tree decorated and crib set up. Lots of help will be needed and no experience is necessary – just a willingness to help out and a spirit of enthusiasm.

Parish 150 Club: The delayed November prize draw of the parish 150 Club will be made in the Garden Room after the 10:00 am Mass on Sunday 17th December. Catholic East Anglia: The December edition of Catholic East Anglia, the Diocesan newspaper, is available in the church porch. This is free – please do take a copy home and read it. The edition includes a report on the first Caritas

East Anglia Festival and the visit of an East Timor Cardinal to two diocesan parishes. Also included is a report on the new Director of Music for the diocese, a tribute to a renowned Norfolk nun and Bishop Peter meeting all East Anglian school heads for the first time. The newspaper is also available to read on-line on the parish web site – just scan the QR code to take you straight to it.
