June is the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Sacred Heart of Jesus have Mercy on us!

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ: Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Previously known as Corpus Christi, which translates from Latin to "the Body of Christ", the most recent revision of our liturgical rites expanded the name of this day to be a more complete reflection of our Eucharistic theology. This feast calls us to focus on two manifestations of the Body of Christ: the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The primary purpose of this feast is to focus our attention on the Eucharist. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist. At every Mass our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it. The secondary focus of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the Gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church. Our worship of Jesus in His Body and Blood calls us to offer to God Our Father a pledge of undivided love and an offering of ourselves to the service of others. The Feast of Corpus Christ is commonly used as an opportunity for public Eucharistic processions, which serves as a sign of common faith and adoration.
