Lent 2025: Wednesday of this week is Ash Wednesday and it marks the beginning of the penitential season of Lent 2025. Ash Wednesday comes from the ancient Jewish tradition of penance and fasting - the practice includes the

wearing of ashes on the head. The ashes symbolise the dust from which God made us. As the priest applies the Ashes to a person's forehead, he speaks the words: *Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return*. Ash Wednesday is a day of penitential prayer, fasting and abstinence which marks the beginning of Lent, a season of penance, reflection, and fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday, through which we attain redemption. Masses on Ash Wednesday will be at 10:00 am and 6:00 pm at both of which ashes will be distributed, and whilst Ash Wednesday is not a Holyday of Obligation, it is good to attend Mass on this day to mark the beginning of this penitential season and begin preparations for Easter in the right way.

Bible Study Group – whilst not specifically a Lenten function, we will start our parish Bible Study Group on Thursday this week. This will be in the Garden Room at 7:15 pm, and the group will start by looking at St Luke's Gospel. Coming along to the group and learning more about the Gospel would be a good additional activity to undertake as part of your Lenten preparation.

The Chosen – also starting in Lent, we will be showing Season 3 of the Chosen over four consecutive Saturday evenings starting Saturday 8th March at 7:00 pm. We will show two episodes each evening, with a refreshment break between and a short period of discussion and reflection. This is highly recommended for all parishioners, and guests, young and old, and again it would be good to do something extra for Lent.

Stations of the Cross – on each Friday in Lent after the 10:00 am Mass, there will be Stations of the Cross. The Stations of the Cross is one of the most simple, yet powerful, ways to prayerfully walk alongside Jesus and encounter him like never before. Attending Mass on Friday and making the Stations of the Cross would again be a good Lenten observance.

Lenten Course – for 5 consecutive Wednesday evenings starting 12th March at 7:00 pm in the Garden Room, Fr Luke will lead a reflective journey through the Apostles' Creed using the Catechism of the Catholic Church. This series of sessions again provides an ideal opportunity for us all to enhance our Lenten observance this year.
