The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process through which non-baptized men and women enter the Catholic Church. It includes several stages marked by study, prayer and rites at Mass. Participants in the RCIA are known as catechumens, and undergo a process of conversion as they study the Gospel, profess their faith in Jesus and the Catholic Church, and receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist. Those Christians who would like to enter full communion with the Catholic Church are also encouraged to join this programme.
